

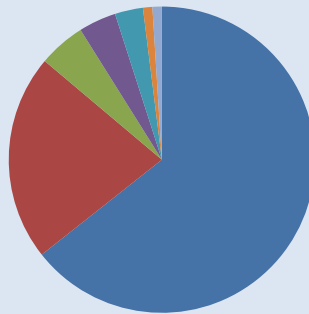
Utah CASA 2021 Annual Report

In 2021 there were a total of **745 active volunteers** serving **1622 children in care**.
Advocates contributed **31,825 hours** while serving child clients.

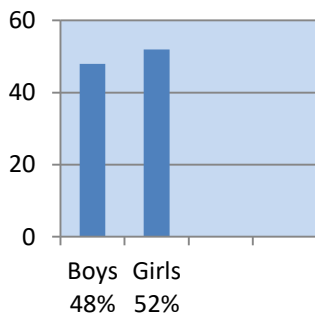

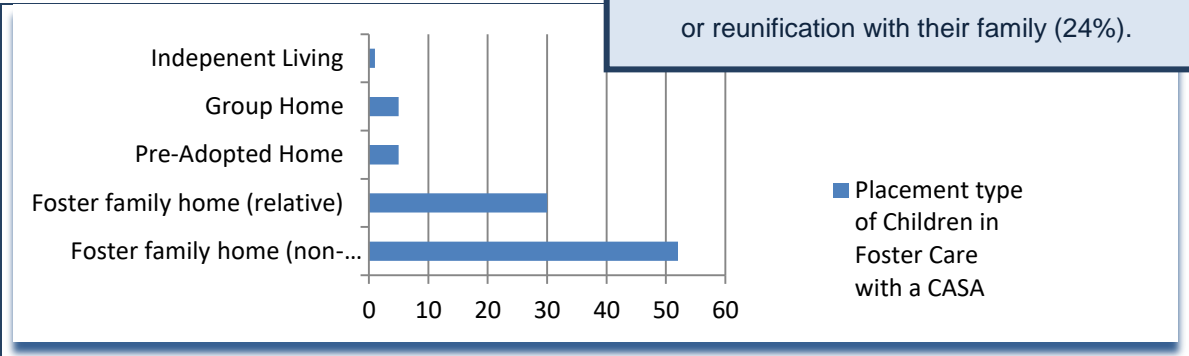
Children served were **mostly White (65%) or Hispanic (22%), and under the age of 12 (65%),** with **29%** of children **age 6 and under**. The program served **52% female** and **48% male** children.

A total of 1622 children were served during 2021



In 2021, there were 772 children placed in out-of-home care. Of these children, 30% were placed with a relative and 52% with a non-relative foster parent.

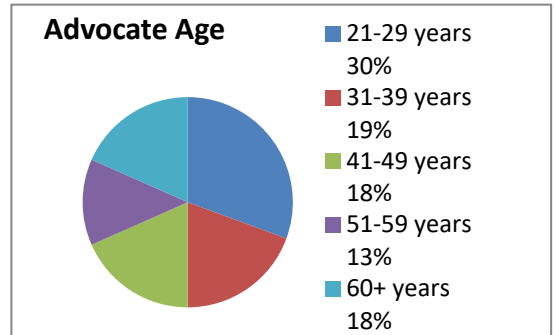
Most common final outcomes for children in closed cases in 2021 were remaining in their home of origin (30%) or reunification with their family (24%).

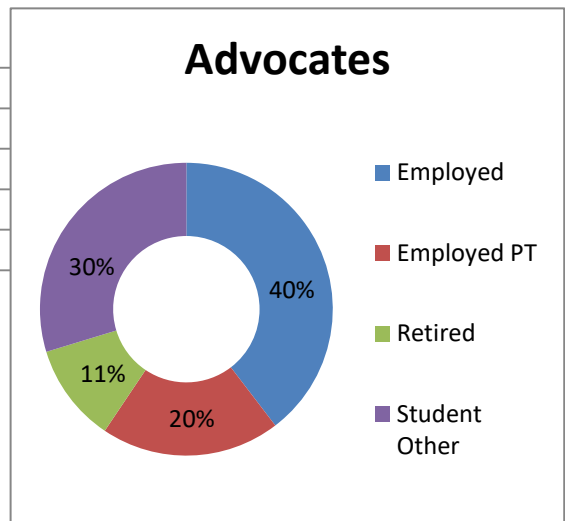
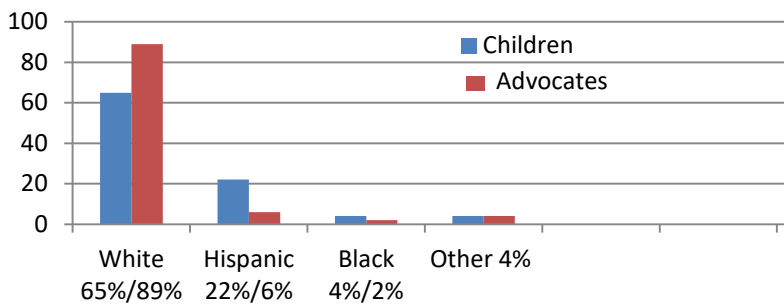
